
# SCI MALAYSIA

## International Representation and Participation

- -Hosted a successful P2P Learning Seminar focus on Fund Raising and Knowledge Management, cum APM and IEC Meeting in Penang in July. Over 22 countries and 50 people participated

#### **Local Activities**

- Successfully held our 27th Penang Peace Run with over 1500 people including 300 with special needs.
- Held a 2 busy and fun filled days for the International Day of Peace event in Sept with over 1500 people from the North and South taking part. Highlight were the installment of a Peace Promenade at the Temple of Universal Spirit, putting up a new Peace Pole in a School, a Peace Lecture by 2 distinguished speakers, a Peace Dinner, a Peace Convoy, Cycle for Peace, Peace Art
- Commemorated the Earth Day with the development of an Organic Garden and Farmacy
- Held Families Day and week end projects with the disabled at Spastic Centre and School for the Blind,
   Penang. Also participated in Book Launch and Food Fair to support like minded organisation
- Support a new initiative; Dialog Rakyat which is to promote national Peace and Harmony particularly amongst the various races and community with Forums at the Universities, and Resident Communities
- Set up a new refresh website for SCI-Malaysia which is mobile compatible
